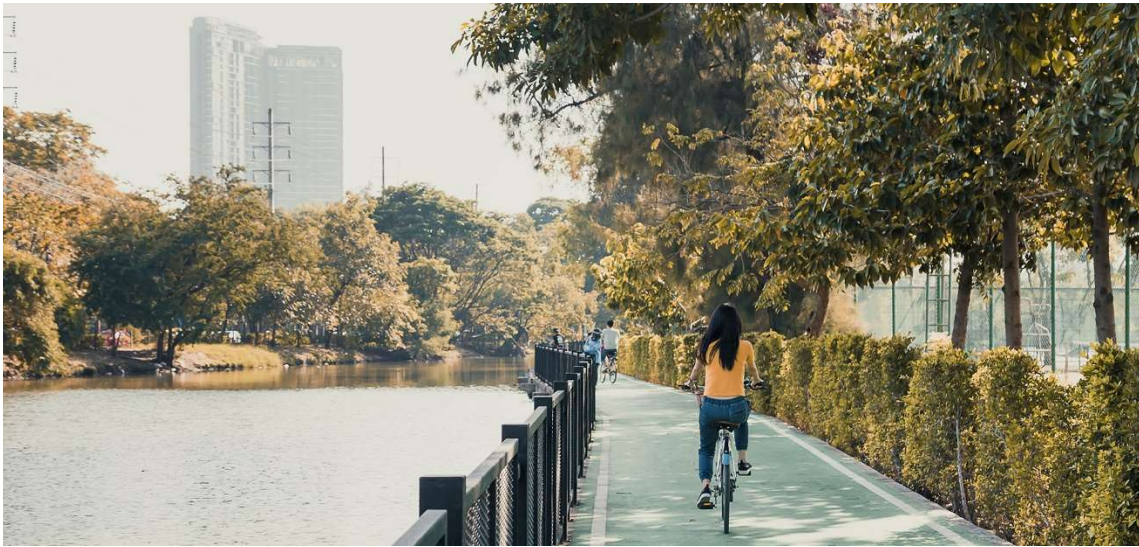
Kieback&Peter signs CEO Letter 2030 For more climate neutrality
